

What is TIP and what do you need to do to complete it?

TIP: Tutorial for Info Power, is a set of modules and a quiz that introduce students to library resources and research skills. Taken in order, this tutorial takes about one hour to complete.

To successfully complete TIP, you need to read through the modules and take the quiz. You must attain a score of 85% or better.

Accessing TIP

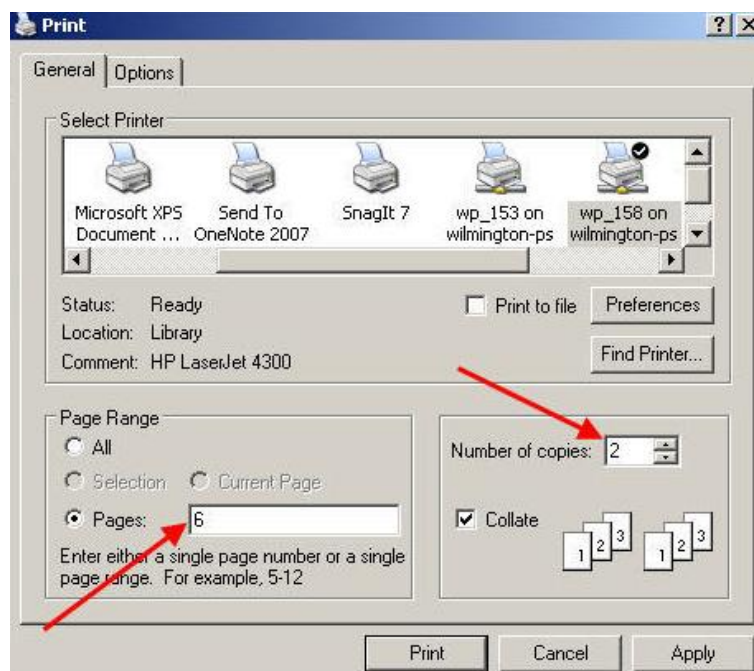
You can also access the online modules by navigating to the library’s homepage, selecting the **Information Literacy** section of the homepage, and then choosing **TIP: Tutorial for Info Power** under Information Literacy at Delaware Tech.

Use the arrow key in the lower right corner to advance the screens. Begin the first module by selecting the **Searching** button and work your way from left to right.

Taking the Quiz

Your first and last name (located at the bottom of the quiz) must be provided in order for you to register and receive credit for completing the modules.

After taking the quiz, if you score less than 85%, click on “clear answers” and retake the quiz before printing your results.



What to Do With Your Quiz Results

All students with a score of 85% or better: **print 2 copies of page 6 (see image on left)**, showing your name and score – one copy for your instructor and one copy for your records.

Stanton and Wilmington Campus students should also print and bring 1 copy to their campus library (Stanton: Room D201, Wilmington: Room W163. The library will keep your results for five years in case you need a duplicate copy).

Warning: TIP does not keep records. You must print your quiz result when you have it on the screen. You cannot go back later to retrieve it.
